Invention: Erasable Pens

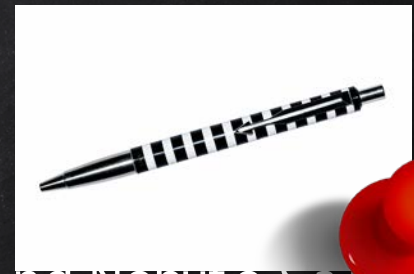
Category: Common

Entertainment - Monopoly here & now

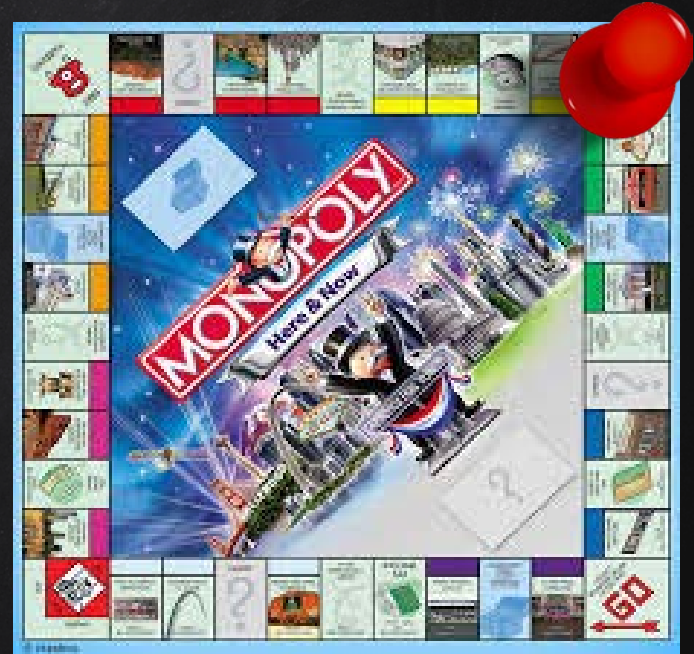
Invention: Monopoly Here & Now
