Action



An action photo is a method of photography that captures an object in action in a single image.

Reaction



A reaction photo captures an object right after an action has taken place.

Rule of Thirds

In a rule of thirds photo, the main object is placed along an imaginary three-by-three grid. This makes the photo a lot more interesting than if it was placed in the center of the image.



Framing



The object of interest is surrounded or framed by other objects surrounding it.



Fill the Frame



To fill the frame means to have a focal point ; the object of interest takes up the majority of the photo.

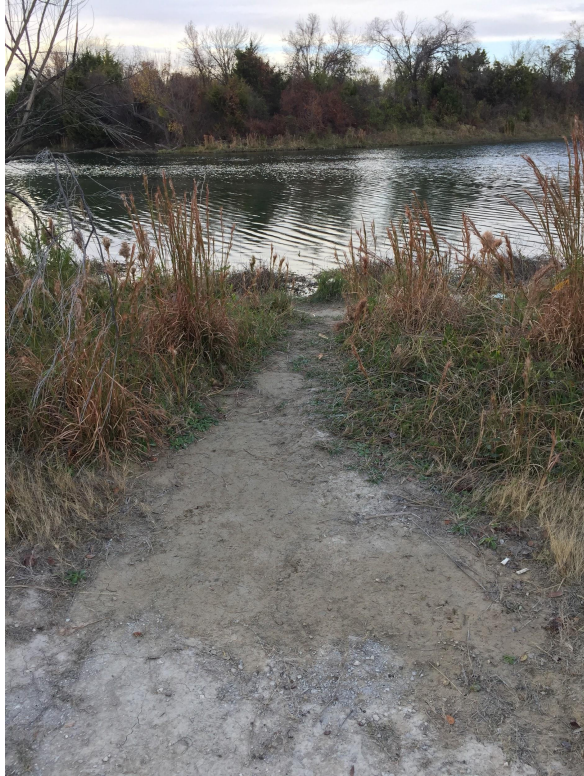
Angles



To capture the photo's subject from a different viewpoint. This makes the photo more interesting.



Leading Lines



Leading lines directs and guides a viewer's focus to the image's subject.
